

A Parish Meeting was held (according to notice duly published) in the Parish Room on Monday the 6th day of March, 1899. at 7 o'clock in the evening, when about 20 Electors were present.

St. Southey Chairman of the Parish Council opened the meeting by reading the notice calling the meeting and having announced that he was a candidate asked the meeting to elect a Chairman when on the motion of Ch^r. J. J. Partridge seconded by Ch^r. James, Colonel Harry Morris Jones was unanimously elected and took the Chair at 7.5 pm.
