Access to
Playing Field
from Gables Rd.

A letter was read from the Secretary of Willand Women's Institute requesting access to the Playing Field from Gables Road. After some discussion Mr. Barnes proposed that the Parish Council should again approach the Devon County Council with a view to their putting forward plans for a rough path without lights etc., a cheaper version of their previous suggestion for linking Gables Road and Somerlea through the Playing Field, this with a view to assisting the ratepayers. Mr. Bright seconded.

Dogs in Playing
Field.

Complaint was made of Dogs being allowed in the children's Playing Field despite the "No Dogs allowed" notice and Mrs. Lemberthy proposed the Parish Council send a letter to Mr. Gale asking him not to take his dog in the Playing Field. Mr. Salter seconded.

G.P.O. Matters.

It was reported that a wire stay of a telegraph pole now comes across the footpath outside Mrs. Dickson's house on the main A.3.8. road also that the Letter Box at Fir Close is too small and the clerk was asked to write the Telephone Manager and Head Postmaster at Exeter concerning these matters.
