Minutes.

The Minutes of the last meeting were read and confirmed.

Accounts.

The audited Financial Statement of the Parish Council for the year ended March 31st 1963 was laid before the meeting and unanimously approved.

Charities.

The Accounts of the Parochial Charities were produced by the Rev. A. Davies, and read in his absence by the clerk of the Parish Council. These were duly examined and approved.

Street Lights.

After some discussion it was proposed by Mr. Muir, seconded by Mrs. Godfrey that a letter be written to the South Western Electricity Board asking for an estimate per light for the converting of lights to mercury vapour (as those supplied at Barnes Close).

Regarding the lighting of the Church Path it was suggested that perhaps the Church Council would come to an arrangement with the Parish Council with a view to the light outside the Church being placed on a longer arm and at a greater height and for this light to be put on each night for approximately



the same period as the Street Lights and on Mrs. Ludd's proposition, seconded by Mrs. Godfrey, it was decided that a suitable communication be sent to the Secretary of the Parochial Church Council.
