Minutes.

The Minutes of the last Meeting were read and confirmed.

Parish Council Accounts.

The audited Financial Statement of the Parish Council for the year ended March 31<sup>st</sup> 1967 was laid before the Meeting and unanimously approved.

Parochial Charities.

The Accounts (uncompleted as the year has not yet ended) of the Parochial Charities were produced by the Rector, examined and approved. Mrs. Barnes objected to the method of distribution of the Charities, and the Rector also the Chairmen explained the difficulty in administering them.

Parish Council Chairman's Report.

The Chairman of the Parish Council made his report on the year's working of the Council.

Proposed new Burial Ground.

It was resolved to provide a burial ground under the Burial Acts, 1852 to 1906; Voting being 16 in favour and 1 against.

Address.

Mr. Neville Jones addressed the Meeting.

Questions followed, after which the Rector proposed a vote of thanks.

Barnes Close.

Mr. H. R. Butt complained about the dirty state of the roads on this Estate and it was decided that the R. D. C. be asked to arrange for these to be cleaned.

Crossing for A. 38. Road.

Mr. D. H. D. Macgill proposed that the objective of establishing a proper and adequate crossing facility on the A. 38. be continued. Mr. L. Wint seconded.
