A Parish Meeting was held (according to notice duly published) in the Village Hall, Willand, on Thursday, March 13th, 1969.

Present:- Mr. S. J. Webber (in the chair), Mr. E. Rogers (Clerk to the Parish Council) and 16 Parishioners.

Apology.

Mr. Neville Jones (County Councillor) sent an apology for his unavoidable absence.

Minutes.

The Minutes of the last meeting were read and confirmed.

Parish Council Accounts.

The audited Financial Statement of the Parish Council for the year ended March 31st 1968 was laid before the meeting and unanimously approved.

Parochial Charities.

The Accounts (uncompleted as the year has not yet ended) of the Parochial Charities were produced by the Rector, examined and approved.

Parish Council Chairman's Report.

The Chairman of the Parish Council made his report on the years working of the Council.

Footpath - Gables Road to Playing Field.

Following considerable discussion, it was proposed by Mrs. Barnes seconded by Mr. Salker, that the County Education Authority be again asked to move back their gate to a point near the actual School grounds thus enabling pedestrians to reach the Playing Field from Gables Road via the


School Drive and so avoiding the expense of the Parish Council in fencing and making a separate footpath parallel and right alongside the present drive. There was one dissenter to this proposition.

Education.

Mr. Hunt asked about the Lurney School particularly with regard to the apparent low level of eleven plus passes by the pupils and was told that this matter is at present under consideration by the School Managers and County Education Authority.

Dean Hill Road.

Mr. Tucker complained of the state of this road, he said the ditches badly need cleaning out and he considers the stinging nettles should be cut two or three times a year.
