Parish Council Accounts.

The Accounts (uncompleted as the year has not yet ended) of the Parochial Charities were produced by the Rector, examined and approved.

Parish Council Chairman's Report.

The Chairman of the Parish Council made his Report on the year's working of the Council.

Playing Field.

Mr. Potter complained about the surface of the Playing Field and it was suggested that he be included on the Committee if possible.

Mr. Webber proposed that Mr. Hunt be elected to the Playing Field Committee to replace Mr. Macgill.

Vote: - 8 For. 3 Against. 2 Abstentions.

(b) No objection to sharing with Wffculme parish.


Vote: - 6 For. 4 Against. 3 Abstentions.
