Minutes.

Parish Council Accounts.

Parochial Charities.

The Accounts (uncompleted as the year has not yet ended) of the Parochial Charities were produced by the Rev. Agnew, examined and approved.

Parish Council Chairman's Report.

The Chairman of the Parish Council made his report on the year's working of the Council with thanks to the R.D.C. Representative Mr. S. J. Webber.

Mr. Banwell thanked the Chairman for a very good report and Mr. Salker thanked Mr. Bordes for taking on the job of Secretary for the youth club improvement at the Village Hall.

Improvement of Lighting in Station Road.

Mr. Salker pointed out the bad lighting in Station Road and proposed that the

lights should be improved right through this Road to Strong, Howle + Strong's premises at the Parish boundary. This was seconded by Mr. Downes who thought the Parish Council should fight for both a speed limit and good lighting for this road throughout its entire length.
