PLAYING FIELD COMMITTEE MEETING 14TH JULY 88

- 1/ The Willand Residents Playing Field, Sub-committee had indicated it was now disbanded, due to lack of time.
- 2/ The £500 grant allocated by Mid Devon District Council had not been set aside for any special playground equipment, the Parish Council committee therefore decided to rethink the projects previously suggested.

It had been noted by the clerk: -

(a) The Devon North Community Agency had been disbanded.

(b) The Council for Christian Care its replacement organization had also ceased to function.

(Both were concerned with the Councils Recreational Requirement.

- 3/ Mr Webber had attended a Sport & Play Information Day.
(Devon Playing Field Association)

Members discussed details of Advised Equipments together with costing.

It was agreed, Mr Williams a resident (Master Carpenter) should be approached with a detailed diagram of the selected equipment with a view to manufacture and installation. A cost exercise was the initial requirement.

The £500 grant could be scrapped for. A new equipment, a small National Playing Field Grant could be applied for also.

- 4/ Mr Player having repainted very successfully the Swing, should be asked, if he would tidy the Hedge, which was becoming Overgrown.

Mr Player had noted the Roundabout required repair once again, and he would be willing to repaint on completion.
