Minutes of the on-site Meetings held on 26 February 1992.

a. Playing Field - to consider Grant application to MDDC

Decision:

Recommend to Council that consideration be given to revamping the childrens play area on the lines of that now provided in Uffculme. Clerk to approach Uffculme Clerk for information.

Other Matter

Agreed to replace the broken seat in the field with a large tree trunk. Such a tree could also be placed at Willand Moor - Councillor Webber has knowledge of two such trunks.

b. Cemetery - to consider provision of Trees and alteration to Garden of Remembrance.

Decision:

- a. Recommend that two variegated holly trees and two acer trees (Japonicum) be provided. Mr Denton be asked to purchase whichever he chooses.
- b. Garden of Remembrance.
That 18 sq.in. plinths be placed under each plaque, provided that, where necessary, next of kin give consent to the cask being moved and, that the legal requirements are cleared with the Home Office.
The cost of this for existing plots will be met by the council (£600 plus labour), the charge for future interments to include the plinth and with the proviso that plaques must be provided.

c. Allotments

At the request of the clerk some members were able to look at the Sheds that have been built by holders. It was agreed they be approved.
