

WILLAND PARISH COUNCIL**MINUTES OF PLAYING FIELD SUB-COMMITTEE
17 MARCH 1996 IN PLAYING FIELD AT 9.30AM**

28. Meeting had been called to discuss the proposed gates

After examining the gates at both ends of the field, the following was decided.

a. Village Hall end

The gateway into the leased part of the premises, was not large enough to permit a disabled persons vehicle which meant that the inner concrete post would have to moved. This could be done when DCC repair the Village Hall fencing. The gate at that entrance could be removed and used at the Somerlea end but it would have to be enlarged. The gateway entrance into the field was the right size but the area immediately in front would need to made up of concrete or tarmac as would the area the field side to take the turn of the wheels.

b. Somerlea End

The brick pillar would have to be removed. the gate from the VH end was large enough to be used with a new post.

It was agreed that the estimate from M D Fabrications, which included rising butts rather than springs, be accepted.

c. Lighting

Clerk explained the position and the committee felt there was a need to pursue the lights in any way possible.

d. Grant from MDDC

Clerk to liaise with Councillor Maynard on the grant application.

Closure: Meeting closed at 10.15am

Footnote:

Since the meeting, the clerk has examined the lease agreement with DCC, which contains a clause referring to two gates at the Village Hall entrance. The clerk is writing to DCC seeking agreement to the alteration to the entrance, the gate will need to be enlarged and a second gate made up for the Somerlea end.
