52. Move of War Memorial

Clerk outlined the position and the need to complete the Faculty Application form received. Rev Agnew also spoke on various matters and raised the question of planning approval being required.

(a)The information needed at questions on the form were provided as follows:

3. Estimates were not available at present.
4. Parish Council will meet the full cost of the work and £1,000 had been set aside for the work to be completed this financial year

- 9 (c) Architect/surveyor had not been approached.
- 10 Two local builders are to be approached for estimates.
- 13 The work will be commenced as soon as possible after approval has been received and is thought it will take 2 to 3 months to complete.

Note: It has been confirmed that planning approval will be required and, because the Church is a Grade 1 Listed Building, the whole application has to go to the Department of the Environment. Application is being completed.
