2. Resignations

The Chairman announced that both Mr Steele and Mrs Barfoot had formally tendered their resignations. The Council expressed their sadness about both resignations.

3. The Church Hall

A letter has been received from Mr Herniman of the PCC regarding the potential sale of the original Church Hall. Mr Vearncombe proposed that the building was not required which was seconded by Mrs Lane. Willand Parish Council will formally thank the PCC for considering the Council first but it was unanimously agreed that the building was not required due to its location. The Clerk is to write to Mr Herniman.

4. Mr Snow's Animal Sanctuary

Mr Snow has gone to the press regarding his animal sanctuary. Mr Dennis wrote to Mr Snow as agreed by full Council at the meeting on 14 February stating that the Council had no desire for him to go, but that the sanctuary needed to be managed better and tidied up. The caravan needs to be removed and any buildings contravening building regulations should be removed unless planning permission is sought. The Council understands that the landowner, Mr Rowe, has given Mr Snow notice to quit. Any call from the press should be directed to Mr Dennis.
