2. Update on environmental issues

Allotment – Cllrs had been to look at the situation but had been unable to speak the resident of the property that backs on to the allotment.

Footpaths – Steve Gardener from DCC has looked into the dismantled railway and will be able to advise us of land owners, he is meeting with Sheila on 16.8.08 at 10.00am.

Sheila has written a letter regarding creating a footpath by the river at the end of Dye House lane – clerk to send letters to land owners.

Muxbeare Lane – national speed limit sign, 50 mile an hour sign next to the Halfway House public house. Should there be a 40 mile an hour limit in between. 20-30 mph speed limit – report to Cllr Radford.

Deralict garage - Somerlea – 32 Somerlea – rubbish by the garages left by residents. Residents rent the base from MDDC and then they build their own garage on to it. Notify the Police about fly tipping – clerk to email PC Katie Rich.

Dean Hill Road – footpath number 2 has not cancelled - contact Gary Pilling about a ramshackle shed in the field by the motorway.
