

A Parish Meeting was held (according to Notice duly published) in the Parish Room, Willand, on Tuesday, January 14<sup>th</sup> 1930.

The Clerk read the Notice convening the Meeting which was called "To consider the proposed Sewerage Scheme for the Parish of Willand in view of the Ministry of Health Inquiry to be held in the Parish Room on the 16<sup>th</sup> inst."

After considerable discussion and inspection of the Plans Mr. W. J. Thome moved the following resolution :-

"That in the opinion of this Meeting the proposed Scheme, as it stands, is unnecessary for the present and that it would be sufficient if the Village Sewer were connected at point "A" on the Plan (near the School) and carried to a Septic Tank at point "B" (the far corner of Mrs Tracey's field) with outfall into the existing Channel. This was seconded by Mr. Gillett and carried unanimously.
